- The language of the manuscript must be in English (either American or British standard, but not the mixture of both)
- Abstracts should not be more than 300 words;
- Full paper should not be more than 7000-8000 words (MS Word format with 1.5 line spacing in A4 size, using Times New Roman Font size: 12;
- Submission of full paper should include: paper title, abstract and keywords (not more than five words); and references in APA reference style;
- Author should clearly state their mailing address, phone number and email address (corresponding author should be stated in case of multiple authorship)
